

# Seoul Travel Guide for Accessible Tourism

## Master Plan to Make Seoul a More Accessible Tourism City

In 2017, the Seoul Metropolitan Government announced a master plan to make Seoul a more accessible and friendly city for all, regardless of their physical, sensory, or cognitive abilities.

With this in mind, the Seoul Tourism Organization opened the doors of the Seoul Danurim Accessible Tourism Center in April 2019, introducing wheelchair vehicles, certificates of universal tourism facilities, an online information platform, as well as working on raising awareness of the need for accessible tourism.



## Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles

### Seoul Danurim City Bus Tour

One-day city sightseeing tour, visiting 2-3 major tourist attractions by wheelchair accessible tour bus

<b>Target</b>	- People with disabilities - Seniors over 65 - Children under 8 - Accompanying guardians and assistants * maximum 4 people per party
<b>Capacity</b>	29-seater, including 8 priority seating
<b>Operations</b>	Tue. - Sat. 10:00~17:00
<b>Fare</b>	Free



### Seoul Danurim Minivan Tour

Wheelchair accessible minivan tour designated for small groups of tourists

<b>Target</b>	- People with disabilities - Seniors over 65 - Children under 8 - Accompanying guardians and assistants
<b>Capacity</b>	8-seater, including 4 priority seating 9-seater, including 2 priority seating

Tour Type	Course	Capacity
Recommended Tour	2-3 major attractions in Seoul/suburbs of Seoul	Depending on courses
Self-Guided Tour	Route as desired by tourists	Actual expenses (cost of gas, parking and toll fees, etc.)



## Universal Tourism Facilities Certificates



Seoul Tourism Organization subsidizes hotels, restaurants, cafes, and other tourism facilities to make their environment more accessible to everyone. Also, the Organization has been working on certifying accessible tourism facilities and providing information on them on the Seoul Danurim website, so that Seoul can be a more accessible and enjoyable city for all.
